- set objectives and targets these are measured, monitored and analysed routinely and reviewed through cross-functional employee meetings. Performance is communicated to relevant interested parties,
- identify legal and other requirements and to subsequently fulfil these, with routine evaluations of conformance.
- understand our hazards and apply the hierarchy of control to eliminate or reduce our occupational health and safety risks,
- · continually improve our processes and our occupational health and safety management system,
- actively consult and engage our workers and our health and safety representatives to participate in occupational health and safety.

Appropriate resource shall be made available to ensure safe systems of work realise our occupational health and safety management system.

The occupational health and safety management system is reviewed continually through cross-functional meetings and the policy amended to reflect any significant change; this policy shall be issued annually unless amended as a result of change.
